

## **Resolution 1013 NO. 2021**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LONE CONE LIBRARY DISTRICT  
BALLOT ISSUE 6A  
ASKING THE VOTERS TO FREEZE THE LIBRARY'S  
COLLECTION RATE AT THE CURRENT RATE TO ALLOW THE  
LIBRARY TO MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS**


WHEREAS, the Lone Cone Library District (formerly the San Miguel R2Jt Public Library District No. 2) was created by the voters in November 1978 upon the petition of Mrs. Lena Nix and Mrs. Louise Robinson of Norwood (the "**Library District**"); and

WHEREAS, the repeal of the Gallagher Amendment of the Colorado Constitution in 2021 has left the library's budget vulnerable to current and future attempts to lower property assessments rates, which would reduce the library's revenue; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to protect the Lone Cone Library's revenue and make their budget more sustainable, the Board of Trustees undertook to go to the ballot to have their revenue stabilized; and

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Town of Norwood supports the Lone Cone Library's Ballot Issue 6A to ask voters to freeze the library's collection rate at the current rate so that programs, services, and staff may be maintained and community needs consistently met.
